Druridge Pools

Access/entrances:

Access (NZ275963) is alongside a minor road running alongside Druridge Links, with the entrance indicated by a NWT sign and through a wide gap onto a level grass path. A further entrance gives access to a viewing area on another grass path, 400m south, alongside the same minor road. Parking is plentiful on the road side.

Terrain:

Terrain is level and flat, but paths can be wet and muddy.

Paths:

A narrow path runs alongside the western edge of the reserve, from the hides to a stile leading to the ruins of a chapel at Low Chibburn. The main path includes two sections of boardwalk, and the southern path also has a short boardwalk.

Facilities:

There are two hides, one with level access and one accessed by four steps. There is also a viewing platform at the southern end of the reserve which is accessed by three broad steps, and an information board on site.
