Harbottle Crags

Access/entrances:

Access is from a track leading uphill from the Forestry Commission car park (NT922040). Follow the fingerpost to 'Drakestone', and the track leads to a single gate alongside a padlocked 5-bar gate. Along a grassy track a second gate leads onto the moorland area.

Terrain:

Terrain is steep but reasonably even as far as the second gate, but rough and rocky with a narrow path on the moorland area.

Paths:

A public footpath runs from the FC car park through the northern edge of the reserve as far as the MoD firing range, and then northwards leaving the reserve and entering West Wood for a round trip back to the car park. The path is steep, rocky and extremely narrow in places.
